Sub: Tamil Nadu Information Commission – Appeals filed by Senior Citizens – Early hearing of Second Appeals – Orders – Issued.

Under the powers vested with the State Chief Information Commissioner in section 15(4) of RTI Act 2015, it is hereby ordered that if a Senior Citizen aged 60 years and above, files an appeal / complaint to the Commission with identity for proof of age (viz., date of birth certificate issued by any Government Institution / Agency / Local Body, like Identity Card, Ration Card, PAN Card, Aadhar Card, Driving Licence, Passport, Educational certificate, certificate from Local Bodies like Panchayat / Corporation / Municipality, or any other authentic and recognised document), then such appeal / complaint shall be taken up for hearing preferably within 8 weeks on priority basis before the Commissioners concerned.
